has a three-percent increase in his salary to \$32,403.80. Rosas told the Council he will begin college this fall to complete the two years he needs to graduate. Discussed at the May meeting was the longstanding water leak at the intersection of TX194 and CR625 (Cemetery Road). The Cemetery's water system has not been operational for some years, according to Sarah Hart, president of the Hart Cemetery Association.
