Oscar Medina Guizar, 27, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Driving While Intoxicated, 1st Offense. He was sentenced to 90 days in jail, probated for one (1) year, \$750 fine, \$435.10 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee, \$100 Food Donation to the County Jail and has to attend a repeat offender class at his own expense.

Robert Lara Jr., 20, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Possession of Marijuana, under 2 ounces. He was sentenced to 60 days in jail, probated for one (1) year; \$500 fine, \$317 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee and \$100 Food Donation to the County Jail.

Ricardo Chavez-Fernandez, 20, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Reckless Driving. His guilty plea was set aside and was placed on six months Deferred Adjudication Probation, \$200 fine, \$173 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee and a \$100 Food Donation to the County Jail.
