

Varsity Teams Begin Second Half Of District Play

With Focus On Playoff Berths

After defeating the Lazbuddie Ladyhorns 40-32 here on Tuesday, the Ladies find themselves in third place in district, according to Coach Ruby Romero. Go-

ing into the game and the second half of district, Hart was tied for the second-place spot with Lazbuddie and Springlake-Earth. Nazareth, defending state

champions is in first place.

On Friday, the Ladies take on the Lady Roos of Kress, and on Tuesday of next week, Amherst.

Hart lost to Lazbuddie by 5 in their first encounter of district play. And, Hart beat Amherst and Kress, and lost to Springlake-Earth.

Starting lineup for the Ladyhorns is Point Guard Marissa Godino; wings

Camarie Neudorf and I'Lynne Marquez; and posts Katie Sweet and Audrey Samaniego.

The Longhorns are in second place after defeating Lazbuddie 69-30 here on Tuesday. Hart's district record is 3-2.

The Longhorns defeated Kress earlier in the season, 78-55; Mark Galvan scored 19 points; Justin Garcia, 18; Julian Rojas, 11; and David Cedillo 11.

Against Amherst, Hart lost

59-52. Julian Rojas had 15; Cedilo 12; and Galvan, 11.

The Longhorns lost to Nazareth, 22-75. Raul Gonzales had 10 points in this game.

A hard loss of 63-67 to Springlake is expected to challenge the Longhorns in their next meeting. In this first game, Galvan had 13 and Cedillo 17.

In its defeat over Lazbuddie, Coach Zepeda said it was a team effort.

Other species that can benefit from today's change include the mourning dove, wild turkey, several sparrows, meadowlark and bobolinks.

The Conservation Reserve Program is a voluntary program. FSA contracts with agricultural landowners so that environmentally sensitive land is not farmed, but instead used for conservation. Participants establish long-term plant species that control soil erosion, sequester carbon, improve water quality, and strengthen declining

wildlife populations. In return, participants receive annual rental payments between 10 and 15 years.

Interested landowners can enroll pivot corners in the Conservation Reserve Program at any time. Participants and land must meet certain eligibility requirements. Other restrictions may apply.
