"Between 1885 and 1967, approximately 49,000 homosexual men were convicted of gross indecency under British law.

"In 2013, Queen Elizabeth granted Turing a posthumous royal pardon, honoring his unprecedented achievements.

"Historians estimate that breaking Enigma (the name for the Nazi code) shortened WWII more than two years, saving over 14 million lives. It remained a government-held secret for more than 50 years.

"Turing's work inspired generations of research into what scientists called Turing machines.
