Hart Firefighters Respond To Smoke At Mi Pueblo Restaurant

The Hart Volunteer Fire Department responded on Tuesday, April 14, to a fire at the Mi Pueblo restaurant, located on Broadway, just south of Centennial Bank. Employees of Centennial Bank noticed smoke coming from the rear of the establishment and notified the Hart Volunteer Fire Department. The VFD responded within five minutes.

Hart Fire Marshall Brad Barnes said that the fire was accidental and electrical in nature. He said the fire got hot very fast. Damage was characterized as light.

Restaurant owner Gabriella Martinez had left the building before the smoke was noticed. When she returned and saw firefighters working to extinguish the fire, she was visibly upset.

Building owner Thomas Brooks said that he has insurance on the building. He did not give an estimate of damages. Indications are that Martinez was not going to continue operating the restaurant even before the fire.
