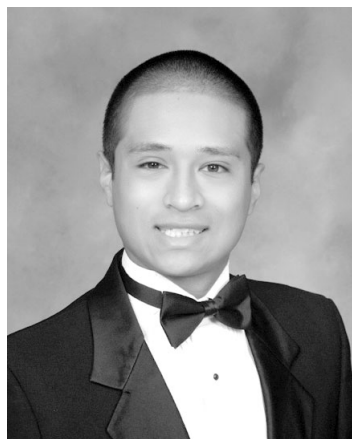

He ran cross country his senior year.

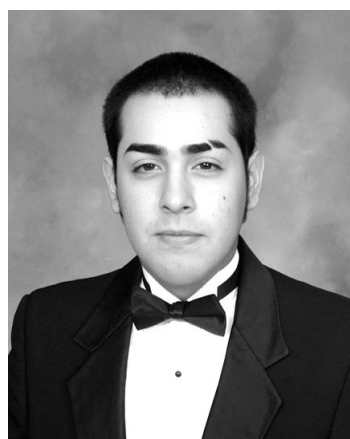

He also was a Tomorrow's Leader.



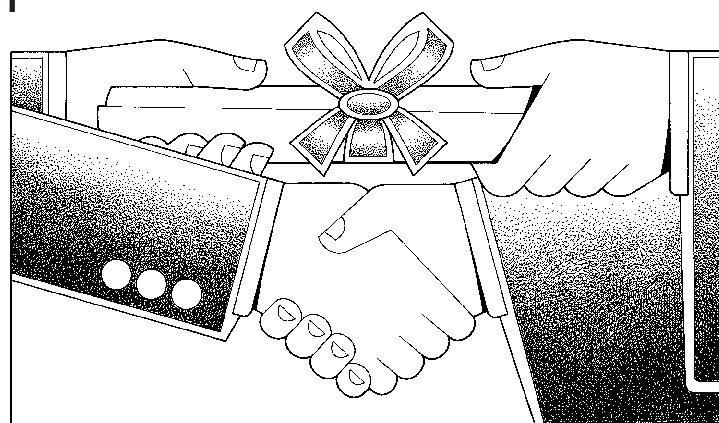
