Judgments for May 27, 2015:

Marco Antonio Medrano, 21, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Terroristic Threat. His guilty plea was set aside and was placed on one (1) year of Deferred Adjudication Probation, \$500 fine, \$173 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee and \$100 Food Donation to the County Jail.

Edd Carson Nelson, 76, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Gambling Promotion. He was sentenced to 60 days in jail, probated for one (1) year; \$1,000 fine, \$307 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee. He was also ordered by the court to forfeit of all funds and items seized in conjunction with the original case.

Jury Trial held on June 2, 2015:

Francisco Cortez, 33, of Dimmitt pled not guilty to the charge of Evading Arrest or Detention with Previous Conviction. A jury trial was held and the jury found him guilty beyond a reasonable doubt. The jury sentenced him to two (2) years in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice-State Jail, \$1000 fine and \$304 in court costs.

Judgments for June 2, 2015:

Angelo Cruz Ybarra Jr., 22, of Dimmitt pled guilty to the original charge of Possession of Controlled Substance, PG 1, under 1 gram. He was sentenced to 18 months in the Texas De-

partment of Criminal Justice-State Jail probated for three (3) years; \$1,000 fine, \$333 court costs, \$50 Crime Line Fee, 240 hours of community service and was ordered by the court to pay \$180 in restitution to the Texas Department of Public Safety Crime Lab.
