HISD Pays \$45,000 In Settlement

It was reported at the Aug. 10 verse findings were noted, and School Board meeting that Hart the audit has been closed. - Approved a memo of understanding with Hale County Juvenile Alternative Education program for the 2015-16 school year. Supt. Ken Rosser said that this is the same agreement as in in another grant application previous years, and the cost is \$25 per day per student. Students mandated to attend the program must get to Plainview at their own expense.
 - The board approved the employee handbook, which had no changes from the previous year. Changes to the student handbook included anabolic steroids for secondary students, and foster care for all grade levels. Approval of a change regarding weapons is awaiting clarification from the school's attorney.
 - Stipends were approved, which included the signing bonuses for math and science instructors, mentor teachers, PEIMS coordinator, dyslexia

sponsors, etc.


