Colonel Patrick Wall Is Commanding Officer Of University Of Arizona NROTC

Colonel Patrick Wall, son of the late Mike Wall of Hart, in July was named the Commanding Officer of the Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps at the University of Arizona in Tucson.

A native of Hurst, Texas, Colonel Wall was commissioned a second lieutenant out of The Citadel in 1989. As a Marine Logistics Officer, he has served multiple tours in the operating forces as a staff officer, company commander, and battalion commander. Most of his career has been in the Pacific Region - serving 15 years there in Hawaii, Okinawa, and mainland Japan.

In 2004, he deployed with I Marine Expeditionary Force to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; in 2009, he supported Disaster Relief Operations in the Republic of the Philippines with the 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit; and in 2011, he ran the Joint Logistics Operations Center for Relief Operations to Japan following the Great East Japan Earthquake, Tsunami and Nuclear Disaster.

His most recent assignment was the Command Inspector General for 2nd Marine Logistics Group, Camp Lejeune, NC.
